Organic Glass & Cans

-It is forbidden to use black bags;
-Expose nappies in separated bags ;
-Use biodegradable bags for organic;
-Any breach of the law may be persecuted.

RECYCLING MADE EASY

WHAT GOES IN

- Food waste (pasta, fruit, bread, meat, etc.)
- Pizza board (only parts containing food residues)
- Tea and chamomile filters
- Napkins (only dirty from food)
- Coffee grounds and coffee filters
- Plant-based cat litter (made from grains, paper or wood pellets)
- Small quantities of domestic animal excreta
- Compostable and biodegradable packaging (make sure in the package is written that you can dispose it in the organic)

WHAT DOESN'T GO IN

- Laminated paper
- Cigarette butts
- Liquids and oil
- Chemicals
- Nappies and sanitary napkins
- Clay cat litter
- Plastics, glass, paper, aluminium
- Wet wipes
- Capsules of coffee

WHAT GOES IN

- Plastic bottles
- Bottles for detergents and soaps
- Yoghurt and ice cream containers
- Thermo insulation polystyrene boxes
- Nets for fruit and vegetables
- Bags and envelopes made of plastic
- Packaging materials (cellophane, film, bubble wrap)

WHAT DOESN'T GO IN

- Toys
- Sneakers and slippers
- Pens and umbrellas
- Disposable shavers
- Toothbrushes
- Photographs
- Cutlery made of plastic

WHAT GOES IN

- Newspapers
- Paper bags
- Paperboard boxes
- Paperboard packages
- Pizza board (excluding food residue and oily parts)
- Tetrapack containers
- Toilet paper rolls

N.B: Please fold up cartons to reduce volume

WHAT DOESN'T GO IN

- Dirty food paper
- Receipts
- Baking paper
- Dirty or oily parts of pizza boards
- Plastic bags
- Napkins, tissue and toilet paper

WHAT GOES IN

- Glass jars
- Glass bottles
- Metal tins
- Foil
- Cans
- Spray cans (only if not-toxic)

WHAT DOESN'T GO IN

- Containers with paint residue
- Ceramic and porcelain (plates, cups, etc.)
- Neon lamps
- Mirrors
- Drinking glasses
- Pyrophile
- Sheets of glass

WHAT GOES IN

- Toys
- Nappies
- Sanitary pads
- Cotton swab
- Wet wipes
- Disposable razors
- Toothbrush
- Cigarette butts
- Plasters
- Coffee capsules
- Clay cat litter
- Plastic cutlery
- Ceramic
- Porcelain
- Stationery
- Lighters

WHAT DOESN'T GO IN

- Batteries
- Oil
- Medicines
- Containers of dangerous materials (glues, paints, solvents, insecticides)
- Neon lamps
- All recycleble waste
